Baby Bunting

QUILT SIZE: 18" × 39"

Materials

FABRIC	AMOUNT	USAGE
Uptown Plush: 1000-7	$\frac{5}{8}$ yard	Flaps
Uptown Plush: 1000-9	$\frac{5}{8}$ yard	Backing
Uptown Plush: 1000-1	$\frac{5}{8}$ yard	Lining
Fabric of your choice	$\frac{1}{8}$ yard	Ribbon casing and piping
Wide ($1\frac{1}{4}$ " wide) ribbon	$1\frac{1}{2}$ yards	Outside ties
Narrow ($\frac{1}{2}$ " wide) ribbon	3 yards	Inside ties
Batting	18" × 39"	
Piping ($\frac{1}{2}$ " wide)	$1\frac{3}{4}$ yards	

Cutting

LAVENDER AND WHITE PLUSH:

Cut one 19" × 40" rectangle from each fabric for outer back and lining.

YELLOW PLUSH:

Cut two 21" × 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for flaps.

WIDE RIBBON:

Cut four 18" lengths for outside ties.

WIDE RIBBON:

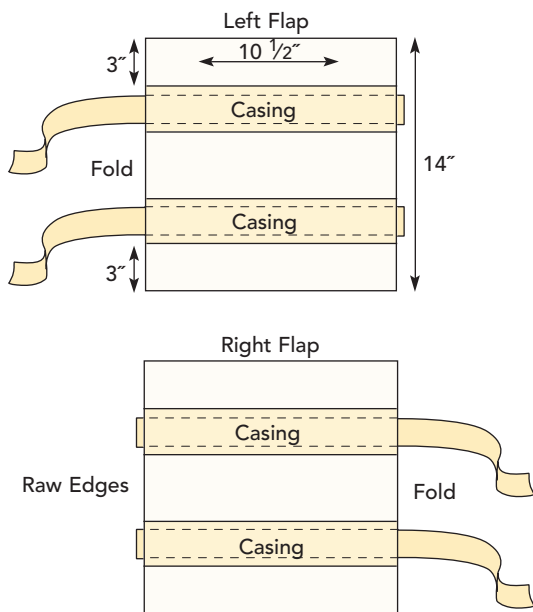
Cut four 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " lengths for inside ties.

FABRIC FOR RIBBON CASING:

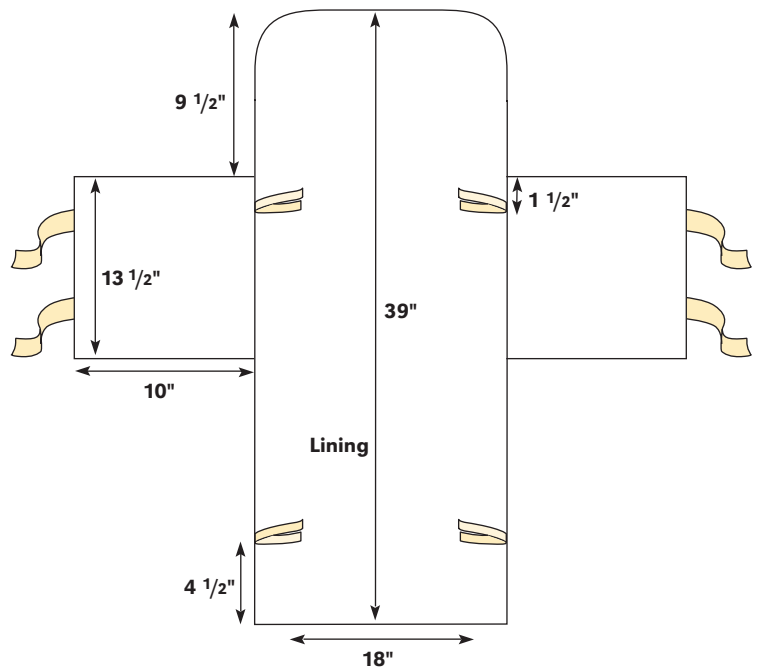
Cut four 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 11" strips.

Assembly

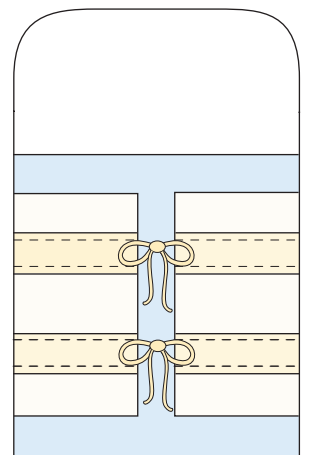
1. Lay the lavender back and white lining pieces right sides together; pin. Fold in half lengthwise, edges matching. Using a saucer as a template, draft and cut a rounded corner through both layers. Trim the batting to match.
2. Fold each yellow flap in half crosswise, right side in, to make a piece 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Stitch along each 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " edge, making a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam. Clip the corners and turn right side out.
3. Fold in both long edges and one short edge of each casing strip $\frac{1}{4}$ ", fold in again, and topstitch, to make narrow hem. Lay the two flaps flat, in mirror image. Position two casings on each flap, 3" from the top and bottom edges with finished edges parallel and aligned. Topstitch the long edges of each casing. Use a safety pin to draw an 18" ribbon through each casing, until $\frac{1}{4}$ " extends beyond the raw edge.



4. Lay the lavender back flat, right side up, with the rounded corners at the top. Lay the right flap on top, casing side down, $9\frac{1}{2}$ " from the top; align the raw edges on the right. Place a $7\frac{1}{2}$ " ribbon tie on the raw edge $1\frac{1}{2}$ " below the top edge of the flap. Baste the flap and ribbon in place along the raw edge. Baste a second ribbon tie $4\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bunting's bottom edge. Repeat to baste the left flap and ties to the left edge.
5. Using a zipper foot, sew piping around the top edge, turning in the raw edges at each end.
6. Place the white lining on top, right side down. Stitch $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance all around, starting and stopping $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bottom edge; leave the bottom open. Turn right side out and press.



7. Put the batting inside the bunting. Fold the raw bottom edges $\frac{1}{2}$ " to the inside and stitch. Sew piping along this edge so it will show when the bundle is folded up.
8. Lay the bunting flat and open the flaps. Using pearl cotton and an embroidery needle, tie the layers together $2\frac{1}{2}$ " below the center top (refer to a basic quilting book for details). Measure down another 4" and make two ties 4" in from the side seams. Measure down another 4" and make another single tie. Continue as established until the entire bunting is tied.
9. To use the bunting, fold up the bottom and tie the inside ribbons, and then fold over and tie the front flaps. Pull the ribbons snug to gather the flaps.
